

3 STEPS TO KEEP YOUR COMFORTER **CLEAN AND FLUFFY**

CHECK THE LABEL.

Many comforters are machine-washable for at-home care. Before you buy one, be sure it doesn't need to be drycleaned or washed in a commercialsize washer. Avoid purchasing one labeled "spot-clean only."




USE A DUVET COVER.

While some people prefer to use a comforter alone instead of tying on another layer, a protector or duvet cover will keep out spills and dirt, and it's easier to wash just the cover on a regular basis. Aim to launder the insert twice a year.

ADD DRYER BALLS.

These keep the fill fluffy and prevent clumping while it dries. You should also pause the dryer cycle a few times to shake and fluff it out yourself. If it's not fully dry, use low heat and repeat the cycle or use the timed cycle.

Doing Laundry It's about much more than just washing and folding! Bending, lifting, and everything else you do while getting the laundry done are compound movements that engage multiple muscle groups at the same time.

WASH LINENS WEEKLY.

Even if they don't look dirty, sheets accumulate dust, allergens and skin cells - not



to mention sweat and germs. Once-a-week laundering is ideal to keep them fresh. Every other week is OK too, but try not to wait longer.

LIMIT FABRIC SOFTENER.

While it's alright to use, too much creates a buildup on the fabric that can affect its breathability. Make sure to measure and follow the amount recommended on the label, and skip it every three to four wash cycles.

AVOID MIXED LOADS.

It may be tempting to wash towels and sheets together, but towels are heavy and take a long time to dry, so sheets get overdried, which may cause



them to shrink and wear faster. If you must mix, add only lightweight fabrics to the load.

Laundry Tips

For College Students Help Them Take A Load Off

With all the studying and extracurriculars that are part of campus life, doing laundry is the last thing college students want to do. Still, unless you're going to pay to get it done or wait until an upcoming break to wash your clothes at home, it's a necessity. But if you don't do it right, all kinds of problems can ensue.

You can avoid the most common laundry goofs by following these tips below.

Find a good time and stick to it: You're more likely to do laundry when it's part of a routine.

Treat stains immediately: Messes happen...we all know that. Use a stain remover or rub liquid detergent into the affected area, which should help it get clean

Separate darks and lights: Pretty logical unless you want your white socks turning blue.

Do larger loads: You'll save time and money. But don't exceed the indicated maximum capacity of the washer and dryer. Remember, if you have to force the door shut, you've overloaded the machine.

Become a 'pod' person: Ditch those big bottles of liquid detergent and the potential spill messes they can create. Instead, use a pod detergent, premeasured packets of cleaner that are convenient and easy to carry. Tide Pods are a good choice.

Use cold water: It's better for your clothes, and most detergents work fine in any temperature. Plus, your ecofriendly classmates will give you props for this green move.

Check the dryer's lint trap: Your laundry will dry faster and come out cleaner.

Empty the dryer ASAP: There are a couple of reasons to do this. First, your laundry (including undergarments) won't end up sitting on top of the machine for the rest of the school to see. Second, you'll prevent wrinkles by folding and putting away your clothes when it's still warm.

Be smart about dry cleaning: You can hand wash some sweaters and shirts even if the tag says "dry clean only," but don't put delicates in the dryer.



some interesting **FACTS ABOUT**Jaundry

If you were to wash and dry one load of laundry every day for 52 years, you'd clean as much as the folks at Walt Disney World Laundry do in a single day. The cast members there launder an average of 285,000 pounds each day. In addition, between 30,000 and 32,000 garments are dry-cleaned daily.

70% OF DIRT ON YOUR CLOTHES IS INVISIBLE

Think those jeans are clean? May want to think again. After a few wears your clothes may still look fine, but according to scientists what's making them dirty isn't necessarily dirt. It's "human matter" like dead skin cells, sweat, natural body oils and also products like lotions, deodorant and soap.

NOT EVERYONE LIKES TO SMELL "MOUNTAIN FRESH"

Fragrance sensitivity seems to be on the rise — a study

out of the University of Georgia found that 31 percent of the participants were irritated by scented laundry products.



He used to charge for sought-after, appointment-only tours that took up to two hours. Then the pandemic slowed business down. At 92, Maxwell decided it was time to cut back anyway.

Except for the special occasion where he grants a group tour, Maxwell has closed his doors.
